



From Invicta to the world, Run like a Dragon!



REGULATIONS - DRAGON RUN 2025





1. Organisation

The Dragon Run takes place in the city of Porto, organised by **GlobalSport**, with official support from **Futebol Clube do Porto**, the **Porto City Council**, and **Ágora**.

2. Races

- 10km Dragon Run: For participants born in 2007 or earlier.
- 5km Dragon Walk: Open to all participants.

Only registered participants are allowed to take part.

Wearing the official Dragon Run 2025 T-shirt is **MANDATORY** for both races.

Both events have a maximum duration of 1 hour and 30 minutes.

After the broom wagon passes, anyone still on the course may continue at their own risk and must comply fully with road traffic regulations.

3. Refreshment Stations

10km race:

- **5km:** Vitalis water
- Finish line: Medal, lunch box, HSN isotonic drink, Bem Boa apple, Super Bock

5km race:

• Finish line: Medal, Vitalis water, Bem Boa apple

These provisions may change depending on weather conditions.

Sunday, 26 October

8:00am – 9:00am: Race Office (Next to Gate 14, Estádio do Dragão)

10:00am: Start of both the Dragon Run and Dragon Walk

Start and finish at Estádio do Dragão

6. Race Bib Collection

Participants must present proof of registration and an official photo ID.

If the selected T-shirt size is unavailable, an alternative size will be offered.

7. Registration

Participants are responsible for the accuracy of the information provided.

Only individual entries are allowed.

The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject registrations.

Registration is only confirmed after payment. Late payments may invalidate the registration. New references can be generated with updated pricing. Refunds for late payments may be requested by emailing <u>tickets@globalsport.pt</u> and are subject to a €3 fee. (Only way to request a refund)





Elite bibs may be assigned to invited runners.

Registration is personal and non-transferable. By registering, participants accept all terms of this regulation and declare they are fit to take part.

Bibs may not be transferred under any circumstances. Unregistered participants are not covered by the organisation.

The organisation may adjust deadlines and participant limits at any time without prior notice.

8. Entry Fees

Until 30 June	5 km Walk – €12 10 km Run – 16€
1 July –14 August	5 km Walk – €15 10 km Run – €20
15 August – 19 October	5 km Walk – €20 10 km Run – 16€
10 – 24 October	5 km Walk – €25 10 km Run – €30

^{*}Children up to 9 years old: €5 (adult prices apply during the final week)

Online payments may incur processing or card fees.

9. Age Categories

10km race: Participants born in 2007 or earlier.

10. Medical Assistance

There will be medical teams present at the event who, in coordination with specialised ambulances, will provide all possible first aid support. Continued medical care, if necessary, will be provided by the national health service.

The organiser is obliged to take out the legally required sports insurance policy, which will be valid and in favour of all registered non-affiliated participants.





Should a participant be admitted to a National Health Service facility, they must inform the organiser as soon as possible so the insurance can be activated. Failure to notify in a timely manner may result in the claim being rejected. The payment of user fees is the responsibility of the participant, who may be reimbursed by the insurer if the claim meets the necessary conditions.

To ensure order among participants and the movement of people and vehicles throughout the event, public authorities, identified volunteers and event staff will be present. Their instructions must be respected and followed at all times.

The organiser, as well as any official or private entity providing assistance, shall not be held responsible for any accidents involving participants, staff or supporters during travel to and from the event or during activities conducted independently of the organiser.

Vehicles not associated with the event organisation are not permitted on the course.

For the safety of all participants, the presence of individuals using motor vehicles, bicycles, accompanied by animals, skateboards, rollerblades or any other objects that could compromise safety will not be allowed.

11. Services

14. Timing

The race will be timed using an electronic chip system. To ensure proper reading, athletes must wear their race bib (which contains the chip) visibly on the front of their chest for the entire duration of the race, and it must be kept in good condition. All participants must use the chip provided by the organiser, which is personal and non-transferable. The organiser will not be held responsible for any failure in result recording due to incorrect placement of the chip. Participants will be disqualified if they: Use a chip belonging to another athlete, use more than one chip, or fail to pass through any of the intermediate checkpoints.

15. Prizes

The prizes for the Corrida do Dragão 2025 will be awarded in the following categories:

- Overall Classification (Men and Women)
 - 1st place
 - 2nd place
 - 3 3rd place

16. Jury

The race jury is designated by the Porto Athletics Association's Regional Arbitration Council.

17. Infractions

Participants will be penalised or disqualified if they:

- Do not wear the official Corrida do Dragão 2025 t-shirt during the race (*Disqualification*);
- Fail to complete the start control;
- Do not follow the full course;
- Do not wear the bib number clearly visible on the front of the chest during the race;





- Falsify any information related to their registration;
- Run with a bib number that does not match the registered name;
- Run on the pavements;
- Intentionally hinder their opponents.

18. Anti-Doping

Participants may be subject to doping control.

19. Image & Data Rights

By confirming their registration, the participant consents to the free and unconditional transfer of the rights to use their personal data for marketing purposes, as well as the use of their image captured in official photos and video recordings taken during the events. The participant agrees to the reproduction of such material in communication channels of the organiser or third parties.

We inform you that the personal data of the participants will be recorded in a file, for which the company "GSX Portugal Lda." is responsible. The purpose of this file is to allow the management of the personal data of participants registered in the races.

The collected data may be shared with third parties for marketing purposes. If you wish to exercise your rights of access, objection, right to be forgotten, or withdraw your consent, you must do so in writing, providing proof of your identity to the address provided or via the email <u>info@globalsport.pt</u>.

20. Final Provisions

Any cases not covered by these regulations will be resolved in accordance with the General Competition Regulations of the Portuguese Athletics Federation.
